Call for Proposals to "ShowTime!"

Ever since the 2012 ECVP meeting in Alghero, there has been an "Illusion Evening" or "Demo Night" where contributors showed their new perceptual effects and illusions.

At this year's on-line ECVP2021, we will be organising a "Showtime!" event in which contributors from around the world will be able to show either (i) a new perceptual effect/illusion or (ii) a demonstration of a novel or unusual laboratory set-up for investigating perceptual phenomena. One advantage of having an on-line meeting this year is that contributors will not have to transport their displays and equipment over continents in order to demonstrate their phenomena. "Showtime!" presentations will be transmitted live from your lab (or home).

If you would like to participate in "Showtime!", please submit a short Abstract describing your new perceptual effect, illusion or laboratory demonstration to: Showtime@ecvp.org.

The "Showtime!" committee will choose the best/most novel submissions for live presentation at the "Showtime!" event on Sunday, 22nd August, just after Jeremy Wolfe's

Perception Lecture (see the ECVP programme at <https://ecvp2021.org/programme/>). All other submissions will be shown in the GatherTown event that follows.

The deadline for the submission of proposals is 6th August 2021.
